

Friends of The Mastodon

Bellevue's Downtown Development Authority (DDA) is planning a new Mastodon-themed attraction. This Attraction will house the bones of "Bellevue's earliest resident" discovered by two local men late in 2014; along with lots of Bellevue historical notes about random and curious topics, most of which have been covered by the local Bellevue Villager Newspaper: the couple who found a gravestone in their yard, the two-story outhouse... odd things that make history fun, all centered around the huge Mastodon bone display.

After significant fundraising over the next several months, the planned attraction will be open to the public regularly, and be available for school group visits, club meetings, specialized tours and self-guided tours, and will feature other various rotating displays throughout the year to encourage return visits.
