D. Swartz moved to appoint M. Behnke to the Village Council vacant seat. No second. Not approved.

S. Roberts moved to appoint Larry Fulcher to the Village Council vacant seat, seconded by B. Balkema. Motion carried.

L. Fulcher was sworn in and took his seat at 7:46 p.m.

D. Swartz moved to purchase a Chevy Tahoe in the amount of \$40,000 plus \$12-\$15K to outfit it to replace the Dodge Charger police car, seconded by H. Coy. Motion carried.

N. Roberts let the council know that Sierra Brown from Infrastructure Alternatives was coming out to tour the WWTP and discuss the possibility of providing a licensed operator. After N. Roberts gets the financial information and if Infrastructure Alternatives can help us, she will email the council with the information. If anyone on the council wants a special meeting then they will request one via email, if not then N. Roberts has the authority to make the best decision possible for the Village.

H. Coy moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:18 p.m., seconded by D. Swartz. Motion carried.
