Council discussed the Fireworks proposal from Night Magic and would like N. Roberts to check on possibly changing the date and how much the American Flag cost and/or what could we put in it's place that everyone could enjoy.

N. Roberts let the council know that the American Legion is putting on the Memorial Day Parade this year and are trying to get more participants. B. Balkema and L. Fulcher indicated that they may be interested in riding their motorcycles in it.

The Council briefly discussed the things that were in the holding area, just to get updated.

N. Roberts let the council know that there was a small sewage spill into the Battle Creek River of 2,500 gallons on Feb 28th. This was caused from the power outage on Feb 27th which caused a power surge and a control board and VFD burned up. It was quickly repaired and the spill was reported to EGLE, the Health Dept and the Battle Creek Enquirer.

Public Comment: Mark McGarry, Bellevue Community Schools Superintendent, was here just to let us know that the school millage will be on the ballot in May. It is just a renewal and that they are not asking for any additional funds currently.
