Fire Board Report – R. Spaulding and J. Jackson explained that the Fire Board is requesting an additional \$1,000 per quarter for increased insurance and operating cost per entity and \$3,000 additional per quarter for a full-time fire/EMS person Monday – Friday during the day per entity. This is a total of \$16,000 per year per entity. The council discussed it and are looking at some different avenues on how we are going to pay for this as our current budget is already stretched.

R. Spaulding moved to adopted the proposed 2023 Village of Bellevue Budget, seconded by S. Roberts. Motion carried with Roll call vote: D. Swartz, S. Roberts, R. Spaulding, B. Balkema – Ayes

The council discussed the proposal from Granite to move the services and billing from WOW to Granite. R. Spaulding asked N. Roberts to check on if a Mesh Network or Cabium Radio Shots would be a better option. N. Roberts will contact IT Right and report back at the next meeting.

D. Swartz moved remove M. Goodrich and add Brandon Balkema as a signer on the back accounts at Independent Bank, seconded by R. Spaulding. Motion carried.

N. Roberts let the council know that D. Miller has resigned from the council as she is moving outside of the village limits. We will be taking applications for the vacant seat until January 5th. The applications will be reviewed and the council will decide at the January 10th, 2023 meeting to fill the seat.

D. Swartz moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:27 p.m., seconded by R. Spaulding. Motion carried.
