R. Spaulding moved to accept the application for the Planning Commission vacant seat from Anissa Olmstead, as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by L. Pfiester. Motion carried.

H. Coy moved to adopt the Fire Protection and Emergency Services Resolution and to move forward with a proposed Special Assessment Millage, seconded by E. Bird. Roll call vote: H. Coy, B. Balkema, R. Spaulding, L. Pfiester, E. Bird – Ayes. Motion carried.

H. Coy moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:14 p.m., seconded by L. Pfiester. Motion carried.
