Pfiester. Motion carried.

R. Spaulding moved to allow the Village of Bellevue attorney to speak with the Bellevue Township attorney. Once we have sent all pertinent information to the Village’s attorney, N. Roberts will contact the Township to get their attorney's contact information, seconded by B. Balkema. Motion Carried.

B. Balkema moved to approve the Village of Bellevue Master Plan with the previously discussed changes. N. Roberts will send those changes to M. Eidelson for the final draft and next step in the process, seconded by H. Coy. Motion carried.

L. Pfiester moved to adopt the following fine/fee schedule for the ORV ordinance: 1st offense is a \$250 fine, 2nd offense within one year is a \$350 fine, and every offense after within one year is a \$500 fine, seconded by H. Coy. Motion carried.

H. Coy moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 p.m., seconded by B. Balkema. Motion carried.
