Balkema moved to adopt the Resolution for the Tentative Award Construction Contract for Phase II Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements to Grand River Construction for \$1,360,000.00, seconded by L. Pfiester. Roll call: H. Coy, S. Roberts, B. Balkema, R. Spaulding, J. Willis, L. Pfiester, E. Bird – Ayes. Motion carried.

B. Balkema moved to adopt the Resolution for the Revenue Sewer Bond Petition, accepting the Certificate from N. Roberts, Village Clerk, stating that it was determined there were insufficient valid signatures and therefore the petition was inadequate, seconded by L. Pfiester. Roll call: H. Coy, S. Roberts, B. Balkema, R. Spaulding, J. Willis, L. Pfiester, E. Bird – Ayes. Motion carried.

The council discussed the DWSRF grant application for lead service lines. It was decided that, with 12.5% in possible grant funding, the village could not fund the remainder of the project at this time. N. Roberts updated the council on the GM Grant for potential new streetlights. Consumers quoted it for \$36,000, not including the boring. The project's total cost will exceed the grant amount, and the village has decided not to pursue it at this time.

H. Coy moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:56 p.m., seconded by E. Bird. Motion carried.
