L. Pfiester took oath of office and took her seat at 7:25 p.m.

D. Swartz motioned to accept the \$711,899.83 bid from Concord Construction & Grading, Inc. for the Jefferson/Madison St. project, seconded by H. Coy. Motion carried with unanimous vote.

Public Comment: John a concerned resident let the council know about three dogs (Pitbulls) on N Main St that attacked him. He has concerns about other residents being attacked. He did report it to Village Hall who advised him to report it to Animal Control as there is an open case/history for the address. Animal Control did issue a citation. John wanted to know what else we can do. N. Roberts is

going to send a letter requested that their property is completely fenced so that the dogs can not get out.

H. Coy asked B. Balkema if he had heard anything else from 313 N. Elizabeth St. on the gas line getting turned off. B. Balkema stated that he has not heard anything, N. Roberts stated that she has not heard anything either.
