The council discussed the Bellevue Mill Dam, and N. Roberts will get the maintenance costs to present at the next meeting. Mr. Stockhausen did agree to sign a new contract with the village to match up to \$500 per year in maintenance and repair costs. Brace Graham discussed a volunteer committee for sidewalks and possible leaf pick-up. N. Roberts will put something in the next newsletter to gauge interest for next spring. N. Roberts updated the council on the M-78 MDOT project, and MDOT is proposing that traffic be detoured through different parts of the village throughout the project; N. Roberts suggested that we ask for pavement improvements on the streets that are being used (Love, N. Main, and E. Capital).
